(OTTAWA, Ont.) January 31, 2008 – Community Foundations of Canada's Conference Planning Committee is inviting interested parties to submit proposals for *CFC Conference 2008. Our Communities. Our World.* to be held in Montreal from November 7- 9th.

The conference – CFC's biggest to date – is an international event highlighting community philanthropy participants, speakers and sessions from around the world.
